What happens after I finish my treatment?

After you finish your last treatment, there will be a few months before your next visit (called your follow-up appointment). During this time, you can contact us if you are having symptoms related to your cancer. We encourage you to reach out to our patient and family support services (see next page for details).

What happens after I chose to stop or not undergo treatment?

If you decided to stop or not undergo your cancer treatment based on your personal preferences, we may not schedule you a follow-up visit with your Care Team. If you have questions about your care plan going forward, please don't hesitate to discuss with your Care Team.

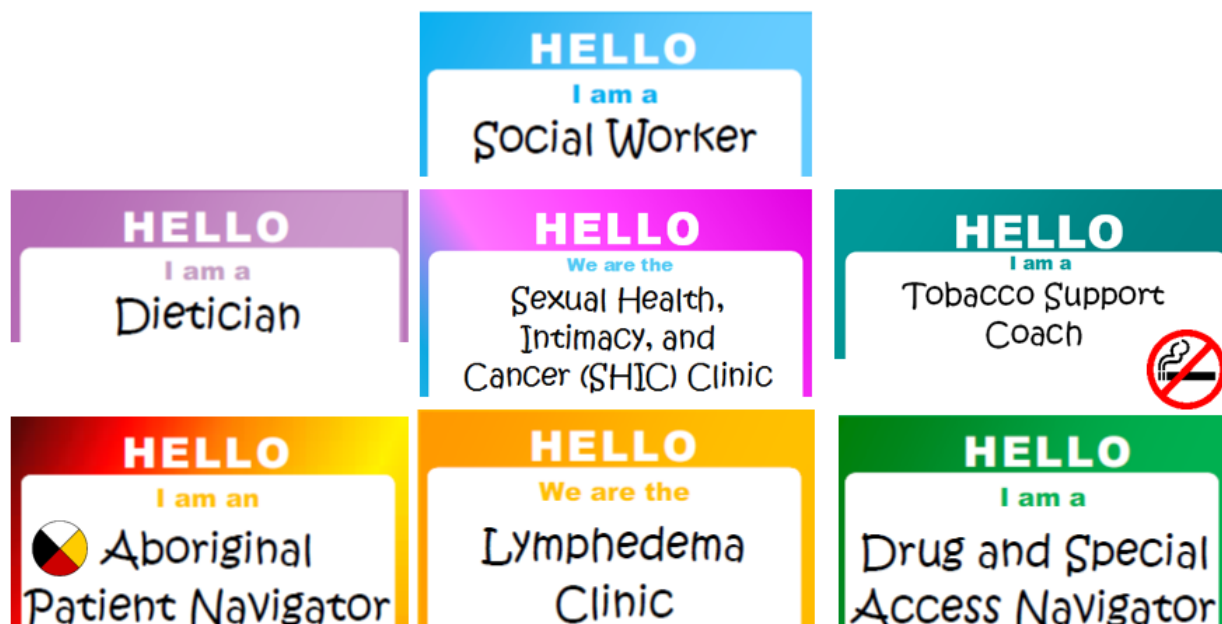

Call Cancer Centre Triage Line 705-728-9090 x79565 between 8:00 am—3:30 pm, Monday to Friday. **Call Bayshore CAREpath 1-877-681-3057** between 6:00 pm – 8:00 am, Monday to Friday; 24 hours on weekends and holidays. If you need urgent medical help, go to the emergency department closest to you. Bring your Fever Card if you have one.
