

### **COVID-19 Routine Precautions**

### Information for Students

## Routine Masking:


- All staff and students must perform hand hygiene, put on a procedural mask when entering facility
- Masks must worn at all times while in the facility
- If in private area (i.e., office setting) or taking a break in a common area (i.e., food court) and can maintain 2 metre distance from others you may remove your mask and place on clean surface.

# **Eye Protection:**

• Eye protection (safety glasses or face shield) must be worn for all interactions with patients.

# Aerosol Generating Medical Procedure:

- Personal Protective Equipment (PPE) required includes long sleeved gown, gloves, N95 mask, face shield and door to be closed.
- Used for any procedure listed on the AGMP list.
- Ensure that the sign below is on the outside of the patient's door.

## Social Distancing during Breaks:

- There are designated areas for breaks to occur. These include the Auditorium, Garden Area on 3NA, the food court, the area by Café Royal and on the 1<sup>st</sup> level by volunteer services.
- **Strict policy** on ensuring that there is a 2 metre distance between staff when your mask is off. Where to sit is clearly marked. Do not move tables or chairs!
- Ensure that you bring a procedure mask with you and a paper towel to place the clean mask so that you can don this at the end of your break.

# Code Blue (Adult and Paediatric) and Deteriorating Patients:

- All Code Blue (cardiac and or respiratory arrest) are considered a Protected Code Blue and students <u>are not</u> permitted to attend.
- Bag valve masks (Ambu bags) are not to be used on any patient who does not have an advanced airway (ET tube or LMA).

### Other Facts:

- Patients are required to wear a mask when care is being provided to them.
  You may have to remind the patient to put on their mask.
- Patients are not allowed to leave the unit unless going for a test or procedure.
- Patients are not allowed to leave the patient care area for a cigarette.
- All patients who have symptoms of COVID-19 or are being admitted from a facility in outbreak will be placed on Droplet Contact Precautions until COVID swab resulted and cleared by IPAC.
