CT Simulation and Treatment Preparation

for Patients Undergoing Pelvic Radiation

For your CT simulation and your radiation treatments you will need to have a

FULL BLADDER and EMPTY RECTUM.

This is done to:

- Improve the accuracy of the treatment
- Minimize the dose of radiation given to the bladder and small bowels. This will help reduce side effects to these organs.

Preparation:

- 1. If possible, try to have a bowel movement before coming for your appointment.
- 2. 1 hour before your appointment, empty your bladder and then immediately drink 2 cups (500mL) of water.

This preparation is **needed** for your CT simulation appointment and **ALL** of your **radiation treatment appointments**.
