Ondansetron (Zofran®) _____ mg <i>Yellow, oval</i> 	Day	1	2	3	4	5	6	7	8

Dexamethasone (Decadron®) 4mg <i>White, 5-sided</i> 	Day	1	2	3	4	5	6	7	8
	# of tablets								
Prochlorperazine 10mg <i>Orange, round</i> 	Take one tablet whenever you feel nauseated. You may repeat this dose every 4-6 hours.
