# Recalling Purposes of the Hub

- Strengthen/build capacity and resources by linking less mature settings to more mature/developed settings/expertise
- Strengthen current partnerships and broker new ones
- Share expertise and capacity for planning, response, and baseline IPAC knowledge
- Regular reporting for situational awareness
- Facilitate operational IPAC supports for homes as needed
- Escalate key issues to OH-Central regional IPAC table
- Increase preparedness and minimize the potential risk of transmission of infection in various types of community congregate settings
- Implement and adhere to established best practice standards and education as per Public Health Ontario
- Strike a standardized response capacity across the province

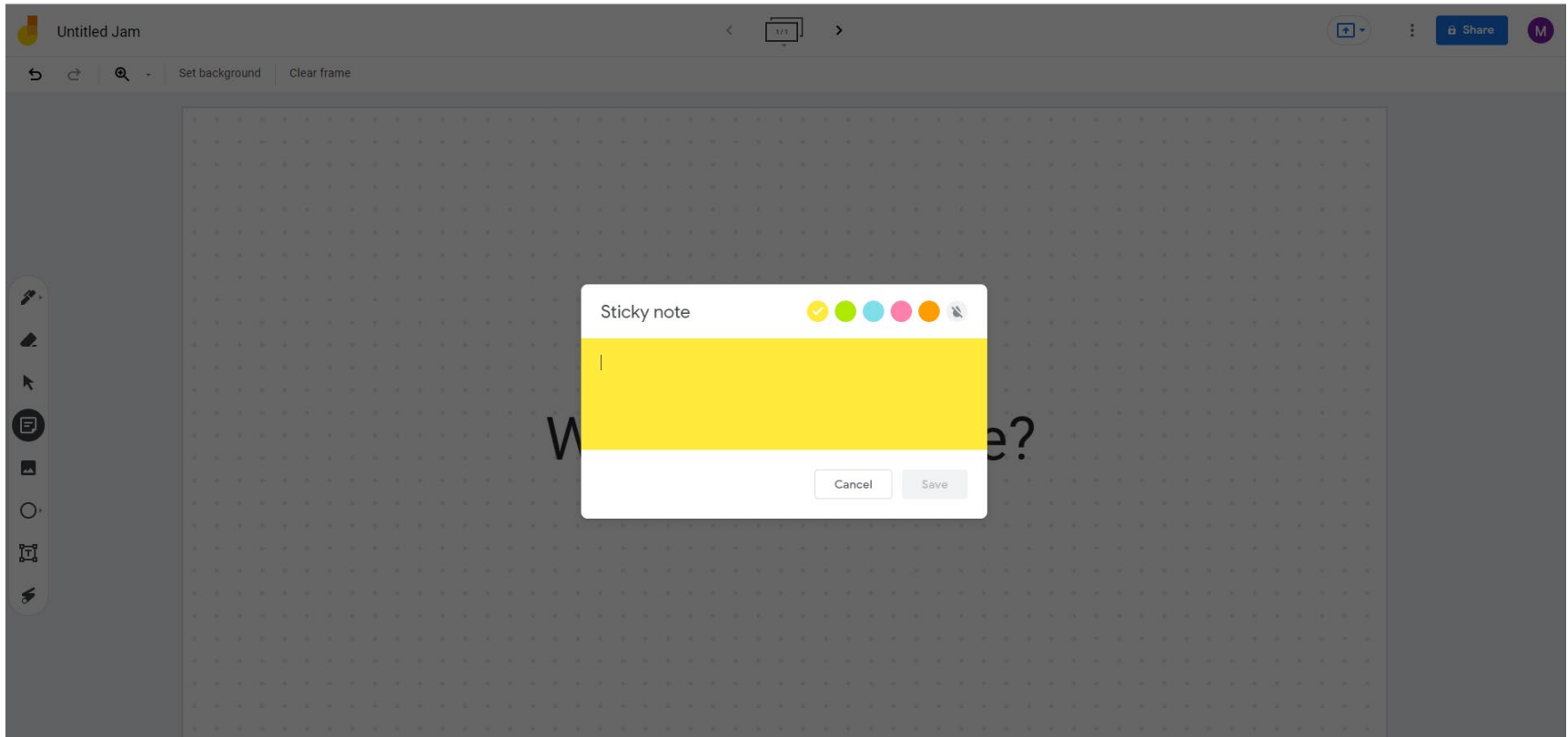


