Clorox

- Bulk wipes
- Need 1 min contact time for most bacteria & viruses
- Effective against
 Clostridium difficile
 - 2 min contact time
- MUST FRESH WIPE









SABER

- Can not mix with Clorox products
- 5 min contact time for most viruses
 - Including VRE & CPE unless working in area with Clorox
- Test weekly and document
- Specified Area for use









Rescue

- Sporicidal Liquid/Gel
 - Liquid room
 - Gel
 - C. Diff in Saber areas
- 10 minute contact time
 Irritant it will burn skin on contact



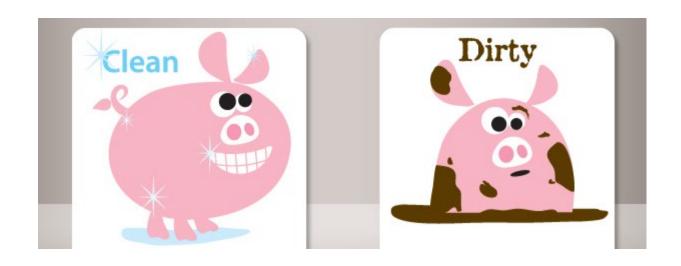






Principles to Follow

- High to Low
- Clean to Dirty (least to most soiled)









High Touch Surface

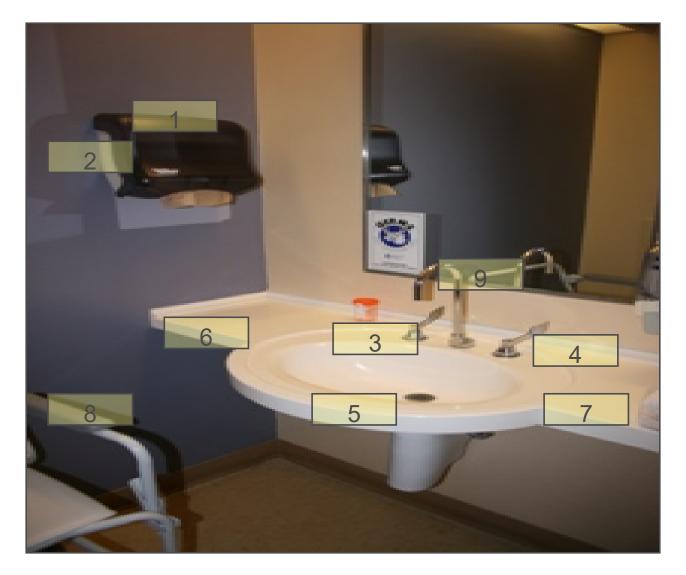
- Frequently touched by hands
- More likely contaminated
- Can transmit organisms to other areas
- Contribute to HAI's
 - e.g. calls bells, bedrails, light switches, edges of privacy curtains

Cleaning Definitions

DAILY CLEAN

High touch points only

Visible soiling

Garbage removal

Linen removal

Floors

NOTE: do isolations first







Cleaning Definitions

DISCHARGE CLEAN

Patients stay is over

Curtains removed only if soiled or monthly

Do not empty dispensers

Walls – shoulder to waist and visible soiling

All surfaces – not just high touch

Empty Room except patient belongings – to be done by HCP







Cleaning Definitions

TERMINAL CLEAN

Patients stay is over on precaution

Patient comes off precaution

Patient is transferred to other room

Discharged patient tests positive AFTER leaving







Cleaning Definitions (Terminal)

All items removed

Curtains (privacy, shower)

Remove 6 reams from dispensers (paper towel, toilet paper etc.)

Walls cleaned shoulder to waist

DOUBLE CLEAN

Clean once

Clean again immediately

TWICE CLEAN

Clean in morning

Clean in afternoon

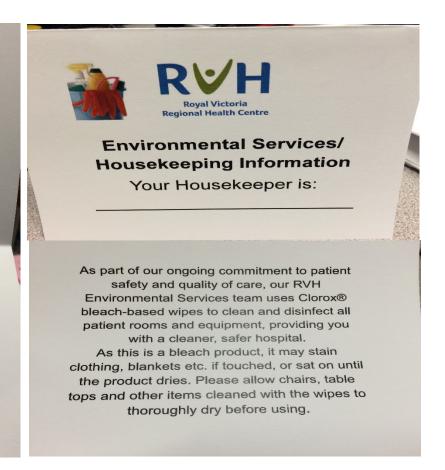
