# How to find the Thoracic DAP Clinic:

The Thoracic DAP Clinic is located in the Regional Cancer Centre at the Royal Victoria Hospital on 201 Georgian Drive in Barrie.

**From Highway 400 North**: Exit Duckworth Street and continue straight through the lights onto Georgian Drive.

From Highway 400 South: Exit at Duckworth and turn left on Duckworth St. and left again at the lights onto Georgian Drive.

#### What is the Thoracic DAP?

The Thoracic Diagnostic Assessment Program (DAP) is a clinic where patients with a suspicion of thoracic cancer can be supported with further testing to rule out or to confirm if they have cancer.

### Why have I been referred?

You have been referred to the Thoracic DAP because you have ongoing symptoms, such as cough or shortness of breath, and/ or there were changes on your chest imaging. Once your appointment is made, the Nurse Navigator will call you to explain what to expect at your first visit.

#### What happens next?

- 1. You will receive a phone call from the program navigator, who will provide you with the date and time of your appointment
- 2. Attend your scheduled Thoracic DAP appointment on Level 2 of the RVH Cancer Centre (check in at Patient Registration)
- 3. Attend your scheduled tests and necessary procedures
- 4. Return to the Thoracic DAP to review the test results and determine next steps with the doctor

#### Do you Use Tobacco?

If you use tobacco (i.e. smoke) and are:

- Not ready to reduce / quit
- Thinking of reducing / quitting
- Ready to reduce / quit

#### What can I expect?

During your visit, a Physician will:

- Perform a physical exam
- Assess your symptoms
- Discuss a plan of care with you
- Refer you to tests and procedures to find out if you have cancer
- Answer any questions you may have

#### What do I need to bring?

- Ontario Health Card
- List of current medications, vitamins, herbal supplements and doses for each
- List of your allergies
- Any questions or concerns you have
- A family member/friend to help you process the information
