

# Simcoe Pod

A satellite building of the Hudson Regional Cancer Centre

RVH is in the process of replacing three radiation treatment machines, so the Simcoe Pod was created to ensure patients have access to radiation treatment in our community during the replacement cycle.

The Simcoe Pod building was recently renovated and equipped with a new radiation treatment machine (linear accelerator) as well as modern spaces for patients to meet with their clinical team.

Effort has been made to schedule all radiation treatment appointments in the same location, but at times patients may need to attend treatment appointments in both the Simcoe Pod and the main Cancer Centre.

Whether visiting the Simcoe Pod or the main Cancer Centre, patients can expect the same quality of care delivered by the same great staff.

Patients scheduled for visits in the Simcoe Pod should be able to arrive independently (e.g., without the assistance of a walker) and should be feeling well. If there is any change in a patient's condition, the care team should be advised before arrival.



## Where is the Simcoe Pod?

The Simcoe Pod is located outside RVH's Simcoe Entrance on the southwest side of the campus.

## Where can I park?

Patients can park in the Visitor/Volunteer parking lot located beside the Simcoe Pod or in any other public parking lot. Patients can also be dropped off outside the Simcoe Entrance.
